The CFO MBA Leadership Program is for second year MBA candidates seeking entry into biotech by providing rotational as well as placement opportunities within the CFO organization at Gilead Sciences. The CFO organization at Gilead is expansive and includes a variety of groups and departments: Financial Planning & Analysis (FP&A), Tax, Treasury, Controllershship, Operations, Internal Audit, Investor Relations, IT, and Corporate Development. The CFO organization supports every area of the company by providing financial analytics, operational expertise (i.e., procurement, project management), fiscal planning, budget forecasting, strategy development and deal execution (i.e., joint venture, partnership, acquisition) as well as managing financial reporting and engagements with external audiences.

We are searching for highly motivated and driven individuals to join the Gilead Sciences CFO MBA Leadership Program.

What We Offer Within the CFO MBA Leadership Program

We will provide program participants with the opportunity to gain valuable cross-functional experiences with exposure to senior leaders, challenging high impact initiatives, and diverse networking opportunities.

- Upon hiring, participants will have the opportunity to rotate through two 12-month assignments over the course of two years.
- The rotation assignments are designed to provide opportunities to learn about different financial, operational, and/or strategic areas of the company.
- After completion of the two years, program participants will continue to develop their careers by aligning to an open position in the Gilead CFO Organization.

Required Qualifications

- Must be at least 18 years of age at the start of the internship
- Must be enrolled full-time in a Bachelor's, Master's, MBA, JD or PhD program at a nationally accredited U.S. college or university, with continued full-time enrollment required in the Fall semester following the internship.
- Must be currently enrolled as an undergraduate (freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior) or as a graduate/doctoral student.
- Must have a minimum overall cumulative GPA of 2.8 at the time of application and hire (official transcripts will be requested)
- Must be independently authorized to work in the United States now and in the future (current or future work authorization must not require school or employer sponsorship) official transcripts are required.
- Must be able to commit to a full-time internship lasting 10–12 consecutive weeks between May and August
- Must be willing and able to work at the designated site for the duration of the internship (relocation may be required). All internships are hybrid; fully remote roles are not offered.
